

## **PATIENT OVERVIEW**

- 49 year old male with past medical history including smoking and hyperlipidemia
- Presented with left-sided weakness and reported garbled speech at breakfast
- o NIHSS: 11
- $\circ \quad {\sf CT} \, {\sf showed} \, {\sf dense} \, {\sf right} \, {\sf MCA} \, {\sf sign}$
- CTA of head showed occlusion of the Right ICA and MCA
- o Patient received IV-tPA

- o Patient discharged post op day 2




## Successful 2 Pass TICI 2B Recanalization of Right ICA and MCA

## **PROCEDURAL DESCRIPTION**

- Angiography documented an occlusion of the Right Internal Carotid Artery & Middle Cerebral Artery
- An aspiration catheter was tracked into the right MCA and a microcatheter was tracked past the clot burden
- $\circ\;$  Two pulls of the stent retriever removed the thrombus from the ICA and MCA
- o TICI 2B recanalization was observed



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
