Acute Ischemic Stroke Follow-up

PRESENTATION:

90 year old male presents to BRH via HCFR at 20:59 with RT sided weakness, RT facial droop, Gaze, with full RT sided hemi neglect. Initial NIHSS was 38. TLKW witnessed at 20:31. Hyperdense MCA sign seen on CT with ASPECT score 10. LVO Alert called at 21:23. IV Alteplase given at 21:35.

PROCEDURAL DESCRIPTION:

Clot Location: Left MCA M1
Pre-Intervention flow: TIC1 0
Procedure: Patient in NIR at 22:08.
Groin puncture at 22:30. Reperfusion of LMCA at 22:44.

CASE CONCLUSION:

Door to Alteplase: 36 mins
Door to Groin: 91 mins
Access to Revascularization: 14 mins
Post Intervention Flow: TIC1 3
Post NIHSS: 2 on 12/21/19
