PRESENTATION:

76 year old Female presents to BRH via HCFR at 07:47 with decrease LOC and seizure like activity. Initial impression fentanyl overdose. Narcan x2 given with good LOC improvement and following commands, non focal neuro exam. Post treatment symptoms evolved into RT sided weakness with aphasia. TLKW witnessed at 07:10 patient w/in Alteplase window. IV Alteplase given at 09:47.

PROCEDURAL DESCRIPTION:

Clot Location: LICA, ACA, LMCA Pre-Intervention flow: TICI 0

Procedure: Patient in NIR at 10:45. Groin puncture at 10:59. Reperfusion of Left cerebral hemisphere at 11:15


CASE CONCLUSION:
